On IMD 2010, The Adventure Club-Pakistan and IbeX Club organized a wall climbing competition, which was participated by 162 registered participants (42 female & 120 male climbers) in various age categories separately for girls and boys, while a lead climbing category for professional climbers was also included in the competition.
