



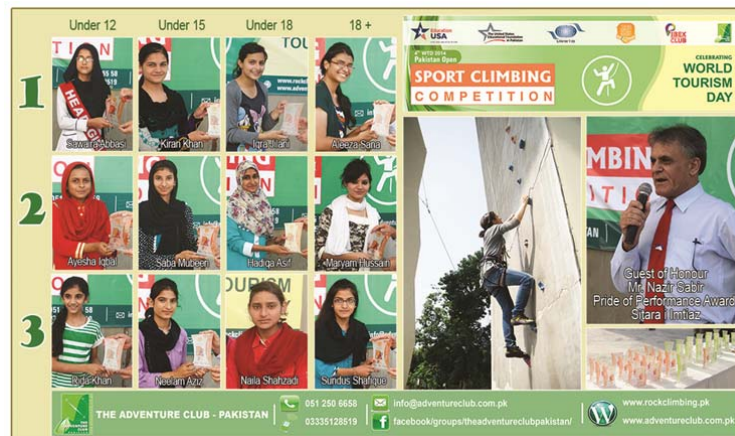
The Adventure Club – Pakistan, established in 1994, has a vibrant history of promoting healthy adventure activities among the youth however the Club has exclusive expertise in Rock/Wall climbing. Besides organizing several promotional campaigns and introductory sessions, the Club has marked and established several climbing routes at various places in the country. The Club has a priority focus on training of climbers as well as producing trainers to cater new climbers.

For the promotion of the activity and to publicize it, the Club introduced a climbing competition for girls only, which was part of celebrations of Visit Pakistan Year 2007, announced by Ministry of Tourism & Government of Pakistan. A memorable event led us to make a new history in adventure sports, especially for females and now the Club has a distinction of organizing 8 competitions on International Women Day (8 March), 6 on International Mountain Day (11 December) and 3 on World Tourism Day (27 September) besides several others at various places and on various occasions.

For 2014, the United Nations assigned the theme for World Tourism Day as Tourism & Community Development and following the theme and keeping the tradition, The Adventure Club-Pakistan organized fourth consecutive climbing competition to mark the day and to contribute in global activities on tourism day.



The event was participated by several schools, colleges and universities, clubs and individuals which include various branches and students of City School International, Elite International, Beaconhouse, Roots, Gosha-e-Mashal, Umar Islamic Model School, Nusrat Jehan Inter College, Comstas University, Nust Adventure Club, DHA 2 Climbing Club, Ibex Club, E-Adventure Sports & Tours and The Adventure Club – Pakistan.



The competitions were arranged for various age categories for girls and boys e.g. Under 12, Under 15, Under 18, 18+ and for professional climbers. The Club has another distinction to include its PWD (people with disability) Chapter and included an exclusive category for Blind people. They were invited for training and then to participate in the competition and it was a wonderful competition as the blind climbers showed great interest and enthusiasm and performed superb.



The competitions were held on artificial wall at Ibex Club which has various routes from easy to most difficult and parallel to international standards. Mr. Esam Khattak, Managing Director of the Ibex Club is always of great support to the club and its efforts to promote climbing activities and was among the guests of honour at the awards ceremony.
